BREAKFAST DIALOGUE G20 Initiative on Bioeconomy & G20 Environment, Climate and Sustainability Working Group

On behalf of South Africa's G20 Presidency, it is our pleasure to invite you to the Breakfast Dialogue entitled, "Strategic partnerships for Africa's Bioeconomy: A G20 Legacy Initiative".

The Breakfast Dialogue will occur within the 3rd meeting of the G20 Initiative on Bioeconomy (GIB) and draws from the cross-cutting priority areas between the GIB and the G20-Environment, Climate and Sustainability Working Group (ECSWG). One of the cross-cutting priority areas that will be under the spotlight, is the Biodiversity Economy. The dialogue kickstarts the preparation of a continental roadmap that will guide implementation of relevant outcomes from Africa's 1st G20 whilst keeping the "All of Economy and All of Society" principle in its endeavors. The Dialogue will also explore roles of the G20 members in supporting Africa to unlock and sustainably grow its bioeconomy.

Expected outcome

Drawing from the discussions and initial inputs towards shaping operational linkages to the GIB, the expected outcome is to develop a clear and actionable roadmap aligned to the Bioeconomy Principles and will guide the sustainable development of the bioeconomy, while foster stakeholder mobilisation and strengthen partnerships through the Global Bioeconomy Platform.
